



Internship Program

TAMIRFILMS offers a free-internship in both production and administration. Interns work directly with individual department heads & staff to receive practical training in production and visual storytelling.

This training program uses music, writing, I.T. techniques and the visual arts to address social and community issues. The program sends students into the community (shadowing), merging the skills of the artist with the needs of society, providing a structure for expression and giving students hands-on experience. The outreach course encourages development of original material by exploring everyday life with a special emphasis on cross-cultural experiences.

COMMITMENT: Our Student Leadership Forum which is held from Dec-Feb requires a minimum commitment of 8-weeks. Applicants will not be considered unless they are able to commit to the full program. We expect a willingness to work hard and high standards of performance. In return, interns are treated as members of our professional staff and receive intensive hands-on experience. We ask that all interns be reliable, conscientious and energetic.

APPLICATIONS: Applicants under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian and the parent or legal guardian must cosign the minor's application and send it with a letter of recommendation (professional or academic). Applicants must write a brief personal statement on what it means to be in the arts.

HANDS-ON LEARNING: Based on the interest of the student and the needs of our current project, each student is placed in a specific department. They will have a departmental mentor who will oversee their work. Tamir's Student Leadership Forum (TSLF) participants work in the following departments: directing, acting, sound, crew, marketing, editing, screenwriting, music production, pre and post- production.

FORUM: Each week, participants meet with a guest speaker to learn more about the craft of filmmaking. Past speakers have included professional directors, playwrights, composers and designers.
